



CATs Primary

CATs Primary is for 5 to 11 year olds. It can be used by teachers to supplement an existing English language course or by children at home to support language learning that they are already undertaking.



CATs Primary is aligned to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).

Each CEFR level is split into small, achievable steps.

CATs Step Into (Primary) is for complete beginners. CATs Step Forward (Primary) assumes children are in a language learning programme and already have some basic vocabulary and grammar.



Each of the CATs Primary levels contains 8 units. Each unit contains two language discovery sessions.

At the end of each unit, there are two challenges that test the language that has been presented in the unit.

At the end of each level, there is a complete practice test before a final certificated test that focuses on the language of the entire level.

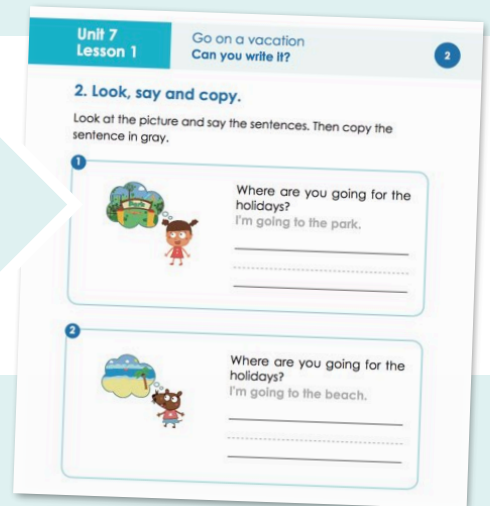
Each CATs Primary level is supported by 20–30 hours of learning and support materials, including pictures, songs, games and animation.

CATs Primary is delivered on a tablet, the young person's media platform of choice.



The flexible self-study approach means learners can study at whatever time and place suits them.

Additional study aids which can be used offline are provided to practise such things as handwriting and vocabulary.



Each CATs Primary level is defined through published lists of language.

Feedback on the unit challenges is engaging and instant.



A guide for parents is integrated into the app. It helps parents understand what is being learned and tested, and encourages them to create useful and fun practice activities with their child.
