
Achievable goals

Test practice

Learners engage in test practice activities throughout the learning units and then have access to complete practice tests at the end of the level. This helps to make sure that they are ready to take the end-of-level certificated test.



Supported learning

With CATs, learners can stay engaged and motivated. A friendly teacher avatar provides audio and visual teaching information and tips. Regular language modelling helps learners understand how the language is used and helps them develop their own language skills.
