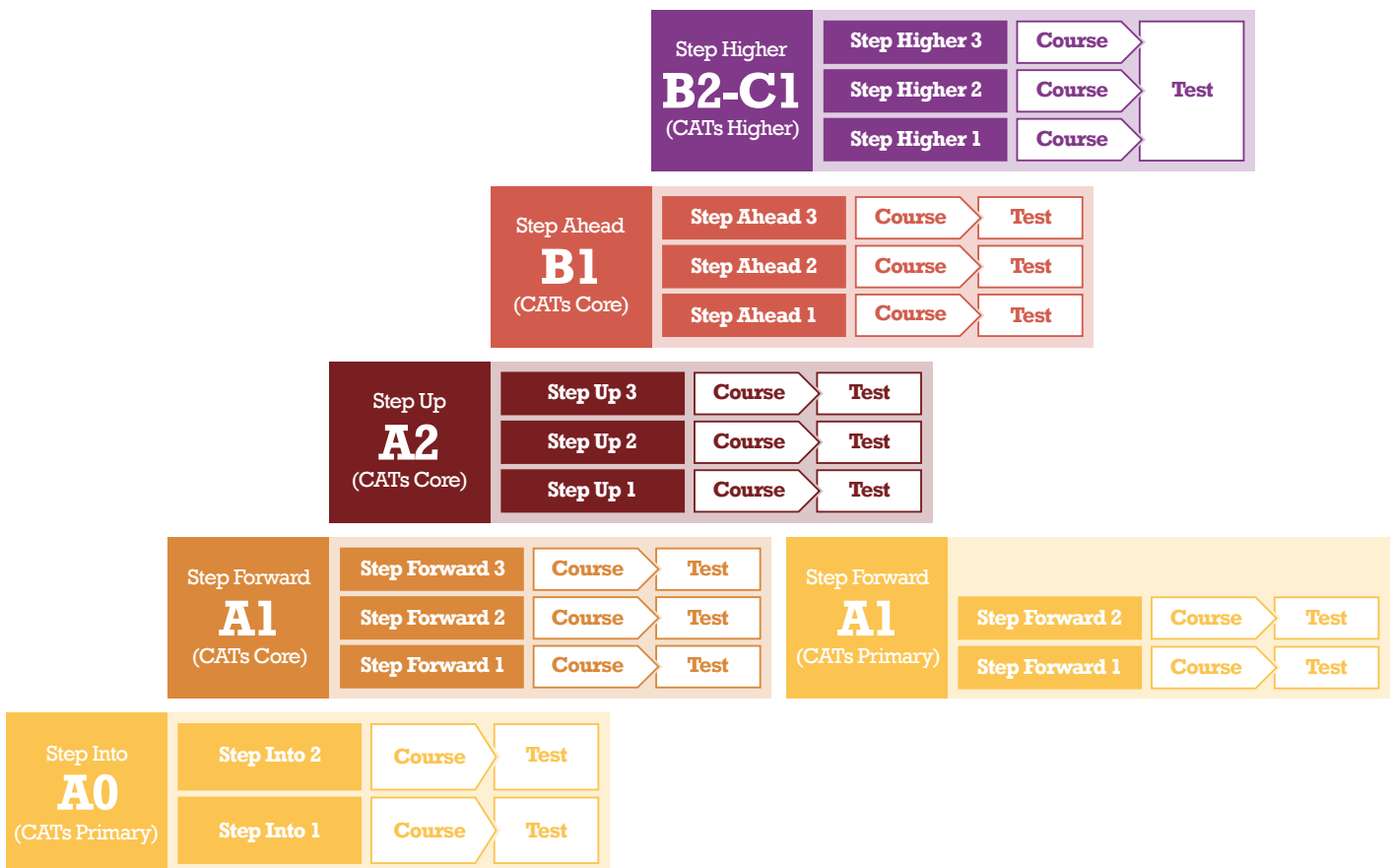




The CATs programme

Most English language courses expect learners to study an entire CEFR level at once. This can take months or even years of learning and isn't a realistic goal for everyone. CATs divides each CEFR level into smaller, more achievable steps.



Each level includes hours of preparation and practice materials. These are available through the web or downloadable onto an app for use offline. At the lower levels, learners can choose to have instructions and guidance delivered in the local language as well as in English. The programme also includes complete online practice tests so that at the end of each level learners are fully prepared to sit the CATs test.

By taking smaller steps towards their goals, learners make real progress and are recognised for their achievements. CATs provides a good foundation for further study. Learners can easily progress onto another English language programme.
